

Goals of DLI:

6

- introduce one new skill each week
- build skills in a developmentally appropriate sequence
- reinforce previously taught skills and provide a weekly assessment
- take about 10 minutes of instructional time each day, preserving more time for authentic writing tasks
- expose students to formats found in formal assessments
- align with state standards and avoid duplication or gaps in instruction

Highlights:

- 30 weeks of proofreading/editing practice tasks
- editing paragraphs
- multiple choice items
- formats like formal assessments
- 30 weeks of spelling lists which correlate with weekly skills
- new focus skill each week
- short daily items M-Thursday
- Review of previous skills
- Friday assessment
- keys for each page
- aligns with State Standard 3: Conventions
