

Goals of DLI:

2

- introduce one new skill each week
- provide engaging mini-lesson activities for skill introduction
- reinforce previously taught skills and provide a weekly assessment
- take about 10 minutes of instructional time each day, preserving more time for authentic writing tasks
- introduce the use of 3 proofreading and editing marks
- expose students to a variety of formats found in formal assessments
- align with state standards and avoid duplication or gaps in instruction
